As mandated by law, BBMP will be collecting the property tax under Capital Value System (CVS) from assessment year 08-09 for all properties. CVS method of computing property tax is not new to the five new zones which have come under the fold of the Corporation after the creation of BBMP. However, in the three zones of erstwhile BMP, the Annual Rental Value (ARV) system is still being followed. But, as the KMC Act does not provide for ARV system of Property Tax assessment and a uniform tax system needs to be introduced in the entire jurisdiction of BBMP, we are implementing the CVS system of tax assessment in the BBMP area. The transition to the new property tax assessment system in Bangalore will not be smooth and easy. But, no efforts will be spared to spread greater awareness about the scheme and help the property owners to file the tax returns without any hassle. A Hand book containing all relevant information about the tax rates, property guidance values, model calculations and Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) will be released soon.
